First place winners received \$100, second place \$75, third place \$50, and honorable mention \$25. Don't miss the 2005 contest rules on page 18. ♦

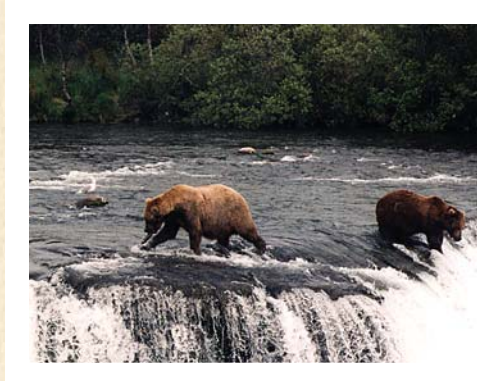

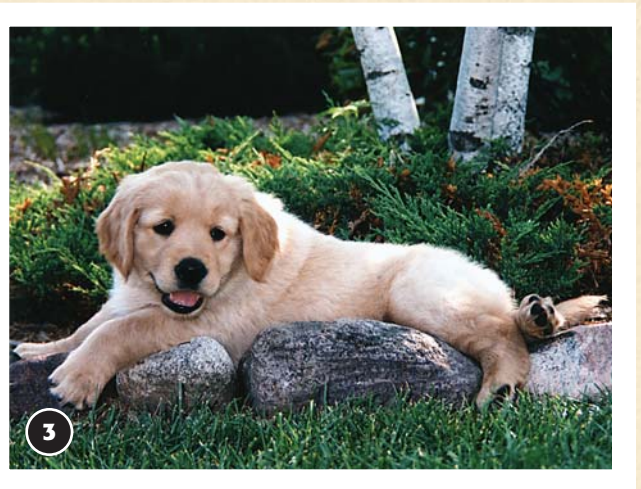
